

SPECIES PROTECTED BY LAW

All species included in the table below are found in trade in Viet Nam. They are, however, protected by Vietnamese Law (Decree No.32/2006/ND-CP and Decree No.59/2005/ND-CP along with Circular No.02/2006/TT-BTS) and their trade, use and consumption is prohibited. Additionally, these species are included in Viet Nam's Red Data Book of threatened species. Furthermore, many of these species included here are listed in Appendix I of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) which Viet Nam ratified in 1994. International commercial trade in CITES Appendix I species is prohibited.

The exploitation, trade, use, and consumption of these species is illegal unless otherwise authorized by the appropriate government authorities in Viet Nam. TRAFFIC, WWF, and the Government of Viet Nam therefore request that people **DO NOT USE OR CONSUME THESE SPECIES** in any form whatsoever.

¹ While pangolins are only listed under Group IIB of Decree 32, they have been included in this list as there is a significant illegal trade in these species which many conservationists believe is having detrimental impacts on wild populations. In recognition of this, parties to CITES have agreed to prohibit international trade until further information about the status of Pangolins in the wild becomes available.
