



SMALL-SCALE FISHING REGULATIONS

PROHIBITED FISHING METHODS AND GEAR

- Makaazi ya samaki/vijambo vya kutengenezwa bila leseni – Fish aggregating device without a license
- Nyavu ya utale/mshipi – Monofilament net
- Kokoro/Juya – Beach seine net
- Zana za umeme za kuteza nguvu – Firearms or electrical shock devices
- Viliipuzi,sumu,vitu vya hatari – Explosives, poison, dangerous substances
- Uvuvu wa mkuki/bunduki – Spearguns

REGULATED FISHING GEAR

Nyavu za mtando/
Juya lenye matundu ya
ukubwa wa chini wa
milimiza 45 – Seine
nets with minimum mesh
size of 45mm



PENALTY

Mtu yeote anayekiuka masharti yoyote yaliyotolewa na kifungo hiki anaafanya kosa na akikwta na hatia atawajibika kulipa faini isiyozidi shilingi laki moja au kutumikia kifungo kwa muhula usiozidi mizei mitatu au yoyote kwa pamoja ikiwa anaafanya uvuvu mdogo mdogo.

Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to both in respect to artisanal fishing


- Jamii zimeorodheshwa kwenye CITES na haziwezi kuuzwa kimataifa bila kibali.


- Nyavu za utale/mshipi – Monofilament nets
- Mtando, juya la kojani, kovogo – Seine nets
- Kokoro/Juya – Beach seine nets
- Bunduki – Harpoon/speargun
- Uzamiaji wa gesi – Scuba diving
- Uzio/Tando – Stakes and weirs
- Nyavu za kokokota (na chombo) – Isipokuwa kwa uuvvi wa kamba mti au

- uvuvi wa samaki wa tabaka la juu) – Trawl nets (unless for prawn or pelagic fishery)
- Kuleta adha au kuharibu makaazi muhimu ya samaki, mazalia, sehemu za kutagia, sehemu za kupumzikia na njia za Samaki – Dredging/scraping of the seafloor
- Katuli – Disturbing the water to herd fish into nets or traps
- Kuvua samaki kwa kumteza nguvu



- Kuchimba/kukwangua chini ya bahari – Dredging/scraping of the seafloor
- Katuli – Disturbing the water to herd fish into nets or traps

REGULATED FISHING GEAR


- Nyavu za dagaa zenyenye matundu ya ukubwa wa chini ya inchii 1.5, isipokuwa kwa uuvvi wa dagaa – Daga/Sardine nets minimum mesh size of 1.5 inches unless fishing for Dagaa



- Madema/Mitego ya madema yenyenye matundu ya ukubwa wa chini wa inchii 3 – Madema traps minimum mesh size of 3 inches



- Nyavu za kokokota(na chombo) kwa ajili ya uuvvi wa kamba mti zenyenye matundu ya ukubwa wa chini wa inchii 2 – Trawl nets for prawn fishing minimum mesh size of 2 inches



PENALTY

Mtu yeote anayekiuka kanuni hii anafanya kosa na aktikula na hatia atawajibla kujipa faini isiyozidi shilingi milioni mbili au kumtumika kifungo kwa muthula usiuzidhi miaka mitatu au vyote kwa pamoja.

Any persons who contravenes this regulation commits an offence and on conviction shall be liable to a fine of not less than two million shillings or to imprisonment for a term of three years or to both

- Uvunaji wa jongoo bahari unaruhusiwa Tanzania visiwani (Zanzibar), lakini siyo Tanzania bara.
- Harvesting of sea cucumbers permitted in Zanzibar but not mainland Tanzania
