1. What does it mean by "DUNS Nr (mandatory for USG contracts)"?

A: A DUNS number is a nine-digit number that confirms your legal status. This number is free; it will take several business days to receive it by email through registration at https://fedgov.dnb.com/webform/. Please do not fill up the service agreement, as the agreement serves as a reference in this tender notice only.

2. What kind of content changes are there in the Spanish and Portuguese version?

A: 10 storyboards will be updated with region-specific examples. Both Spanish and Portuguese version will have the same region-specific examples. We have some pictures that go with each of the examples. Kindly refer to Annex I, pg. iv, Activity Number 7 for details.

3. Is there a link to the e-Modules in English?

4. Who is the target audience for the Simplified Chinese version?

A: Our target audience are those residing in mandarin speaking countries, or those who find Simplified Chinese more learner-friendly, and it is not restricted to a specific country. This is also applicable to other languages.

5. Will a project timeline be sufficient for the Contractor Statement of Delivery?

6. Does the Contractor need to provide translation services?

A: TRAFFIC will provide all necessary translated on-screen texts and script texts.
